# Whose Ears Are Whose?

**Whose Ears Are Whose?** is a rhyming picture book for ages 3 and up.

Who ever heard of a deer with floppy pink bunny ears?

A lamb with great big elephant ears?

A mouse with long, baggy pup ears?

Well, it could happen.

And it does!

When a mischievous little sister gets into her brother's toys, they have a come-apart in a most unusual way, resulting in mixed-up ears, silly antics, and a creative solution that invites reader participation.

Playful rhyme and lively illustrations capture the silliness and hilarity of the wacky situation. In portraying various combinations of possible fits, the ear-bands include fun details such as a lion's shaggy mane, a lamb's woolly fringe, and a deer's spiky antlers.

The unexpected ending has an interactive twist, giving children the opportunity to answer the story's question, "Whose Ears Are Whose?"

**Author Bio:** Award-winning author Lana Jordan graduated from Texas Tech University with a degree in English and has been writing, editing, and publishing ever since. In addition to *Whose Ears Are Whose?* she has written two other books: *Journey to Motherhood*, a guide to pregnancy and childbirth from a mother's perspective; and *The Sleepytime Ponies Trick a Trickster*, where magical flying ponies, southeast Asian folktales, and faraway adventures come together in a fun and educational read-aloud storybook.
